

Welcome back to dance! We are excited for our first week of classes starting Monday, September 10th. The fall schedule indicates the studio that your dancer's class is located in, please be sure to be wait in the waiting room. ****NEW** Upstairs our parent waiting room is next to Studio I. If you have a young dancer, please wait with them there and your instructor will come in to line up and dismiss each class. Studio I & II are located upstairs and Studio III is on the main level. Dancers should bring their bag/shoes in to the studio with them. Please be sure to have their name in all of their belongings.

If you have not made your September tuition/costume payment, please turn it in next week. There are tuition mailboxes in Studio I & Studio III waiting rooms. Your recital costume payments are due with your September thru November monthly tuition. This amount is shown on your registration confirmation. Please let us know if you have any questions. Beginner Level

\$70 for the day or any part thereof. The Beginner Level is a half-day program that consists of 4 morning classes at approximately one hour each, with registration beginning at 7:15 am, warm-up at 7:45 am, and classes beginning at 8:00 am. Classes will conclude around noon. It will be geared primarily to ages 7 and younger with 2 or less years studio experience although true beginners of any age will be welcome.

Intermediate Level

\$90 for the day or any part thereof. The Intermediate Level program consists of a full day of classes which typically includes 8 classes of approximately 1 hour each. Registration begins at 7:15 am, warm-up at 7:45 am, and classes begin at 8:00 am. There is a 1 hour lunch break around noon, and classes conclude around 5:00 pm. These classes are best for dancers ages 8-12 with 2-4 years of studio experience although dancers of all ages are typically represented based on strength of experience and comfort level.

Advanced Level

\$100 for the day or any part thereof. The Advanced Level program consists of a full day of classes which typically includes 8 classes of approximately 1 hour each and a 1 1/2 hour audition class as well. Registration begins at 7:15 am, warm-up at 7:45 am, and classes begin at 8:00 am. There is a 1 hour lunch break around noon, and classes conclude around 6:30 pm. These classes are best for dancers ages 12 and older who work hard and are ready to be challenged. Strong dancers under 12 may also be admitted with studio teacher recommendation.
